Important information about qualifications and documents to bring on reverse.

To be eligible for free EITC tax preparation your income must be less than \$48,300 without business ownership, rental property or capital gains.

Eligibility guidelines for EITC:

- \$43,279 (\$48,279 married filing jointly) with three+ qualifying children
- \$40,295 (\$45,295 married filing jointly) with two qualifying children
- \$35,463 (\$40,463 married filing jointly) with one qualifying child
- \$13,440 (\$18,440 married filing jointly) with no children and were between the ages of 25-65 as of December 31, 2009
- U.S. citizen or resident alien all year

What to bring:

- Photo Identification for all adult family members
- Social Security cards or ITN cards/numbers for all family members
- Date of Birth for all family members
- W-2 forms from employers
- All 1099 forms you received
- Copy of 2008 and 2009 real estate taxes or original signed rent certificate (for Homestead filers) and amount of 2009 Stimulus Payment
- Copy of your 2008 tax return
- If you paid for child care — the provider's name, address, Tax ID Number and amount paid
- If you paid for higher education — Form 1098T
- Social Security/Worker's Compensation/Unemployment Benefits statements
- A cancelled or voided check for direct deposit of your refund and credit

If you are married, both you and your spouse must attend the appointment.
