

Meet Tonya – a single mother of two who works overtime to provide basic needs for her children. Paying for childcare takes up a lot of her income, so she is forced to work extra hours at the expense of not seeing her kids. Tonya doesn't have the luxury of being able to establish simple routines with her family like a nighttime or dinner routine where opportunities for conversations and emotional support arise. Studies have shown that children who do not receive emotional support often experience depression, anxiety, aggression, low self-esteem, and developmental delays.

Tonya recognized the impact working overtime was having on her family and reached out for guidance and assistance. She ended up applying for a Good Start Grant funded by United Way. As a result, her childcare expenses were cut in half and now she can have dinner and a nighttime routine with her children. Most importantly, this single mother can now provide the emotional support her children needed.
