

2022 RSVP Program Highlights

307 RSVP Volunteers provided 34,361 hours of volunteer service at **46** Volunteer Stations valued at **\$1,029,111.00** by Independent Sector.

RSVP is part of a national movement of senior volunteer service programs called AmeriCorps Seniors. Senior volunteers ages 55 and older are placed in community and government agencies to address pressing community needs. RSVP volunteers serve in a variety of settings such as schools, nutrition sites, health facilities, shelters, and other nonprofit agencies.







RSVP Blood Pressure Screening Program restarted with one site in August 2022. Rebecca Richards– Hack, a volunteer nurse provided 35 screenings and related heart health education.

Monthly Coffee Hours and Retirement Well-Being Programs provided free community educational events virtually and in-person, which were attended by **137 persons**.

Over 225 elderly or disabled homebound persons were helped to be able to continue living independently.

Over 830 persons received free tax assistance services.

In the 13 years RSVP has been in Marathon County, **848 volunteers** have provided **468,720 hours** of service helping to build a better community for everyone!
