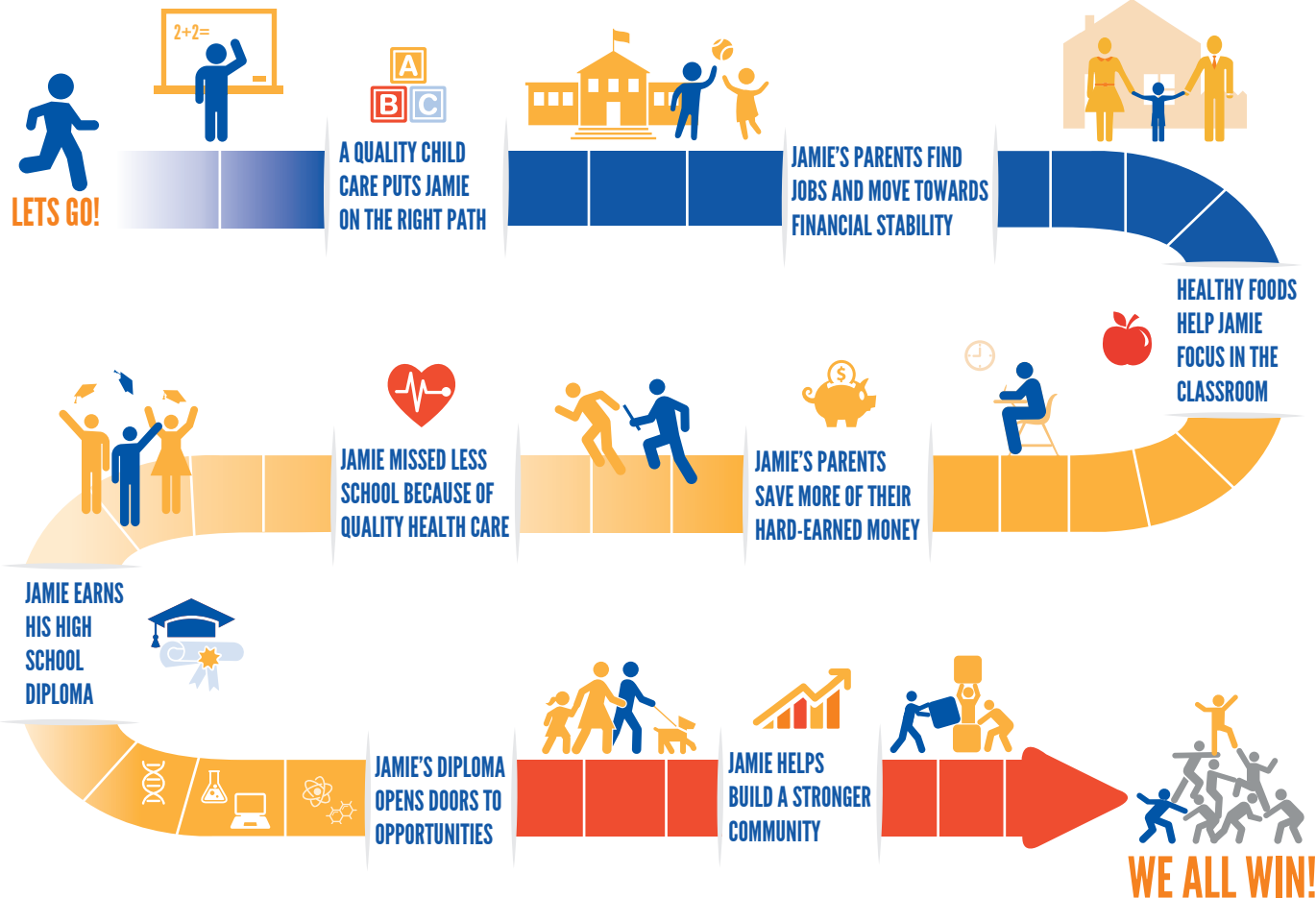

Jane (her name changed to protect confidentiality) lived on the streets but has now found a home. Read her story.

Jane **left her abusive husband**, but couldn't find an apartment that she could afford. At times she and the children were **"couch surfing"** or living with various friends for a week or two at a time. The kids were **sleeping on the floor** and didn't have the stability and security that comes with having a place of their own. The **insecurity** was starting to show in their **school work and in their behavior**.

Jane knew that she needed to make some decisions for her children. Jane connected with a United Way funded **budgeting/financial program** at Catholic Charities. They helped her straighten out her finances and **develop a budget**. Eventually she was able to find a **low rent apartment** and moved in with her children. Next she looked at picking up some **extra hours at work** so that she could start to save a few dollars from each paycheck for emergencies. She is now **current on all of her bills** and has a small **nest egg**.
