



Week of Action we had 70 volunteers give 118.75 hours to serve 18 community agencies through projects addressing HUNGER, LITERACY, HEALTH, and SAFETY.

Projects included Sock Sorting- 2,067 pairs of socks, distributed to 5 schools and 6 agencies.

Make a Difference Kits, 150 kits to be distributed to seniors & homebound adults.

Summer Slide Reading Kits, 200 distributed for 4 school districts with 7 volunteers.

Medicine Safety Kits, 144 assembled for social services and public health with 9 volunteers.

Snack Packs, 1,000 food kits for children with 24 volunteers.

Calm Kits- 100 made for Head Start with 14 volunteers.
