


- What to Bring to Your Tax Appointment:**
- ⇒ Social Security card or ITIN number for all family members
 - ⇒ Driver's license/photo ID
 - ⇒ Last year's tax return and attachments
 - ⇒ Expense records such as medical, educational, and childcare
 - ⇒ Copies of all 1095 forms or other proof of insurance
 - ⇒ Copies of all W-2 & 1099 forms, all other tax documents
 - ⇒ Copy of real estate tax bill or signed original rent certificate for Homestead Credit
 - ⇒ Direct deposit bank account info for depositing refund (optional)

Services: Staff are not available on-site at this location. Virtual service is available via the kiosk by appointment only for clients who have questions about their federal income taxes. Clients may speak to someone via computer monitor.
