The Advocates in medicine Pathway (AMP) program is a partnership between the Medical College of Wisconsin - Central Wisconsin (MCW-CW) campus and North Central Area Health Education Center. It will support the professional development of undergraduates from Wisconsin interested in attending medical school at the MCW-CW to promote a diverse future healthcare workforce built around resilience, relationships, and system-based knowledge. The program cohort runs from January through May, with students attending the 1-credit "Wicked Problems in Medicine: Opioids" course every other Wednesday evening. Community based experiential learning and advising sessions will be held on opposite Wednesday evenings. Students participate in a full-time paid community health internship in June and July.
