**Group/Organization** – collect non-perishable food items and/or build a canned food sculpture and donate to the Marathon County Hunger Coalition through United Way. (This is a great option for youth groups, church volunteers, Scout groups, neighborhoods, summer school programs or book clubs.)

**Sponsorship opportunity** – name and logo will be represented on advertising which may include website, social media, TV commercials and promotional materials. Various dollar options available.

**Donation** – \$250 donation will be directly donated to the food pantries in your honor.

### Guidelines

- For inspiration or ideas view pictures on our website, Pinterest or Google “canned food sculpture.”
- You may build any sculpture. It can be as simple as your logo or as complicated as you wish.
- You may use other props or supporting materials, but your sculpture must be comprised of at least 50% non-perishable food or household goods.
- Food items cannot be altered in a way that makes them unsuitable for donation.
- All teams, in each level, will receive the same food items. Your team must use all of the items and cannot add additional food or household products. You may use things like cardboard, plywood, tagboard, etc.
- All participants must email a photo of their completed sculpture to [solafson@unitedwaymc.org](mailto:solafson@unitedwaymc.org) by September 30, 2021 to be included in online voting.
